Did You Know?

Studies estimate that as much as one-third of all usable, device-produced energy is lost to friction and wear. Reactive maintenance costs three times that of planned maintenance, costing industry and consumers billions each year. In addition to energy waste, friction and wear greatly affect product reliability, maintainability, safety, service, life and environmental factors.

What is a Lubrication Specialist? A Lubrication Specialist is an individual who might be designated a "Lubrication Engineer" by his/her employer. The job description for a Lubrication Specialist includes but is not limited to the following:

- Evaluates and selects the proper lubricants to use. Recommends changes in lubricants.
- Assists in purchasing lubricants by identifying which companies and products can be used interchangeably in a cost-effective manner.
- Conducts lube surveys; specifies lubricants and procedures to those buying or installing new equipment.
- Trains lubricators and assembles work lists for them to use. Establishes lube frequencies on all equipment. Designs or modifies all types of lubricant dispensing systems.
- Develops and implements Quality Assurance and Used Lubricant analysis programs.
- Oversees oily waste collection, reclamation or disposal. Converts as much usage as is economical to bulk.
- Consolidates lubricant inventories to the fewest possible products.
- Maintains records of lubricants by application throughout the plant.
- Troubleshoots and problem solves supposed lubrication failures to identify root cause. Identifies corrective action to take and follows up.

CERTIFICATION INFORMATION

The value of STLE certification has been proven in the market place with increased income and immediate respect and credibility with buyers and peers. STLE offers three certifications, which are valid for three years and then must be renewed. These certifications are designed to be consistent with the standards of the National Organization for Competency Assurance (NOCA), ISO 17024, and also distinguish between a credible real professional and a "self-proclaimed" expert.

Certification recognizes those individuals who possess current knowledge of lubrication fundamentals and theory. Certification is obtained by scoring at least 70% on a three-hour exam with 150 questions chosen at random from a stockpile of questions covering the following subjects:

- Lubrication Fundamentals
- Fluid Conditioning
- Storage, Handling and Application of Lubricants
- Monitoring and Reducing Consumption of Lubricants
- Gears
- Bearings
- Seals
- Fluid Power
- Lubricant Manufacturing
- Pneumatics
- Transportation Lubricants
- Metalworking
- Solvents and Cleaners
- Problem Solving
- Lubricant Analysis
- Lubricant Programs

CLS Certification Test is OPTIONAL.

The test is administered by "STLE".

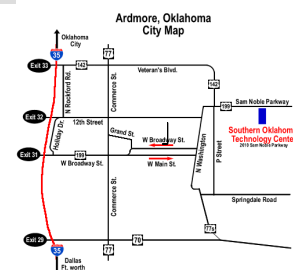
Prices are \$315 for STLE members & \$420 for non-STLE members. Students wanting to test should register 30 days IN ADVANCE on line at <https://stle.org/certifications/cls/application.aspx> There must be a minimum of four members to conduct the test.

All candidates will be notified regarding their exam results as soon as possible. Exams grades are stated as having passed the exam, scoring 70% or above, or not achieving the required 70% needed to pass. No other description will be given regarding the grade status.

The reference materials listed will help you review and understand the subject areas that are covered by the exam. Practical experience of the candidate is of equal importance. Knowing the reference material ONLY will not guarantee passing the exam.
